

Intoxicant Free India Movement

After 9th August & 16th August the third massive protest rally was organized at Badarpur border against the Alcohol Policy of Government of Delhi .



Protest was led by large number of women laborers of Bonded Labour Liberation Front. 5 liquor shops were forced to close down for the day due to furious demonstration. Addressing the protesters Swami Agnivesh pooh poohed CM- Delhi's statement that no new liquor shops will be opened this year. He demanded a state wide referendum on this issue and was confident that more than 80% of Delhites will vote against liquor shops or bars in Delhi.

Alcohol consumption was largely responsible for Delhi becoming the "Rape Capital" of India , said Swami Agnivesh and urged PM Modi to undertake nationwide prohibition of Alcohol as mandated in Art-47 of Indian Constitution and as desired by father of the Nation Mahatma Gandhi during India's freedom struggle. Religious leaders of Sikh faith also denounced Delhi Government's liquor policy and said that CM Arvind Kejriwal should get his own house in order before going to Punjab to set that right.
